After COP21 success in Paris, high expectations for Marrakesh COP22, especially for Africa



COP21:

a historic milestone in the fight against climate change

Target to limit global warming to 2°C officially adopted with aim for 1.5°C

At least \$100 B/year to support developing countries



COP22:

strong expectations to make it a "COP for action" but also a "COP for Africa"



Translate the progress achieved in Paris into reality



Place the most vulnerable regions, especially Africa, at the core of the negotiations



SO FAR, AGRICULTURE AND AFRICA HAVE NOT BEEN ENOUGH TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN CLIMATE NEGOTIATIONS


